

RECIPE

Beat and Bake Chocolate Cake with Chocolate Fudge Icing

Ingredients for the Cake:

Maida – 1 ½ cups Cocoa – ½ cup Butter – 100 gms Eggs – 2

Milk – 1 cup Sugar (granulated) – 1 cup

Baking Powder - 1 ½ tsp Vanilla essence - 1 tsp

Method:

Beat all the ingredients well with a beater till soft and creamy. Pour into a greased and dusted baking dish at 150 deg C for 40minutes.

Ingredients for Chocolate Fudge Icing:

 $\begin{array}{ll} \text{Butter - 50 gms} & \text{Milk - 3 tbsp full} \\ \text{Vanilla essence - a few drops} & \text{Cocoa - 2 tbsp} \end{array}$

Icing sugar – 1 cup

Method

Dissolve cocoa in warm milk, add icing sugar & butter. Cook till boiling. Cool slightly and add vanilla essence. Spread on top of the cake.
